PERFORMANCE TRENDS VS YAGO

- Fresh Potato dollars and pounds decreased, while the price per pound increased versus YAGO
- White and Russets drove the majority of the dollars and volume declines in Fresh Potatoes
- Bag segment was mainly responsible for the overall decline of Russet, Red, White and Purple/Blue Potatoes
- Both Bag and Bulk segments drove the growth of Yellow and Fingerling Potatoes
- Other Potatoes are seeing the highest growth in dollars and pounds, which is primarily coming from the Bag segment

- Except 1-4 lbs and Bulk, all pack sizes decreased dollars whereas Bulk and >10 lbs were the only pack sizes to increase pounds versus YAGO
- 5 lbs Potatoes held the largest volume share; Russet, Red and White drove the dollars and volume decline
- All potato forms, except Yellow declined sales in 10 lbs; Russet Potatoes were responsible for most of the sales decline
- Red off-set the dollar loss coming from Russet in Bulk Potatoes



- ✓ VA Traditional Potatoes represent categories such as Single Wrapped, Micro/Steamers and Trays. Micro/Steamers and Trays, are declining in sales, leading to the overall decline in VA Traditional
- ✓ VA Petite Potatoes are on the rise due to a strong increase in Micro/Steamers and Fresh-Cut Refrigerated pack types. Petites consist of many items that are pre-seasoned and microwaveready
- ✓ VA Specialty Potatoes declined in sales across all pack types (Micro/Steamers, Fresh-Cut Refrigerated and Single Wrapped).
